Community Supported Agriculture (CSA)

CSA has become a popular way to maintain a supply of seasonal produce from local farmers. In short, a CSA is an arrangement between farmer and consumer where the consumer is provided a share (usually a box of fresh produce) on a weekly basis through the farming season. Weekly shares are constantly changing to reflect the crop harvest of that week. It's a great way to guarantee your house will be stocked with in-season, fresh, and local produce. Additionally, it's an opportunity to experiment with produce you may have never tried before.

Why Eat Local?

Eating locally grown food enables consumers to get the freshest food options available. Additionally, you are supporting local agriculture and supporting the local economy because when you buy local foods, your dollars remain in Orleans County. What's more, your food isn't traveling across counties and states to reach your table thereby making locally sourced food more "green".

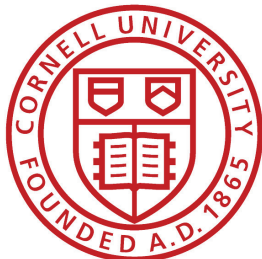

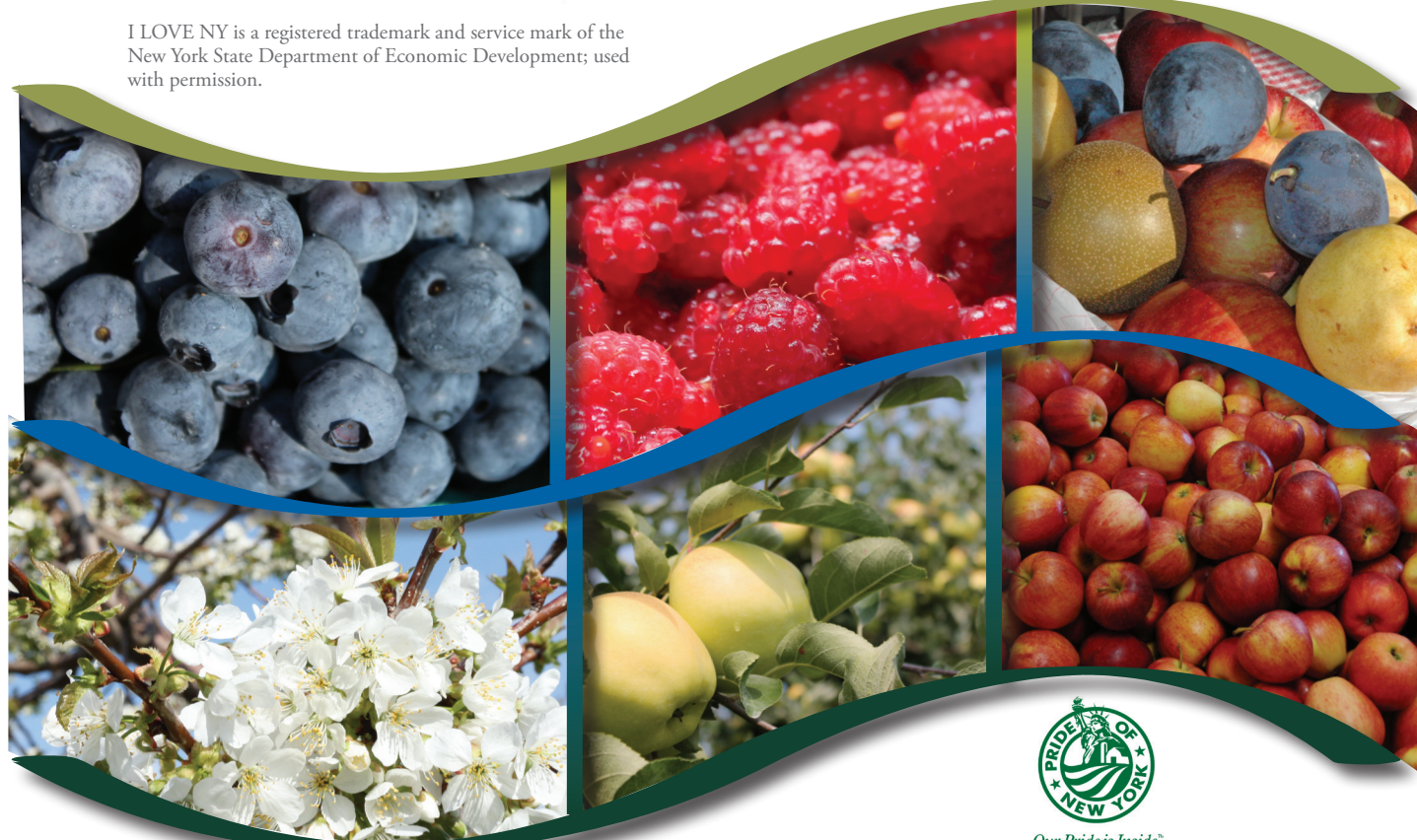

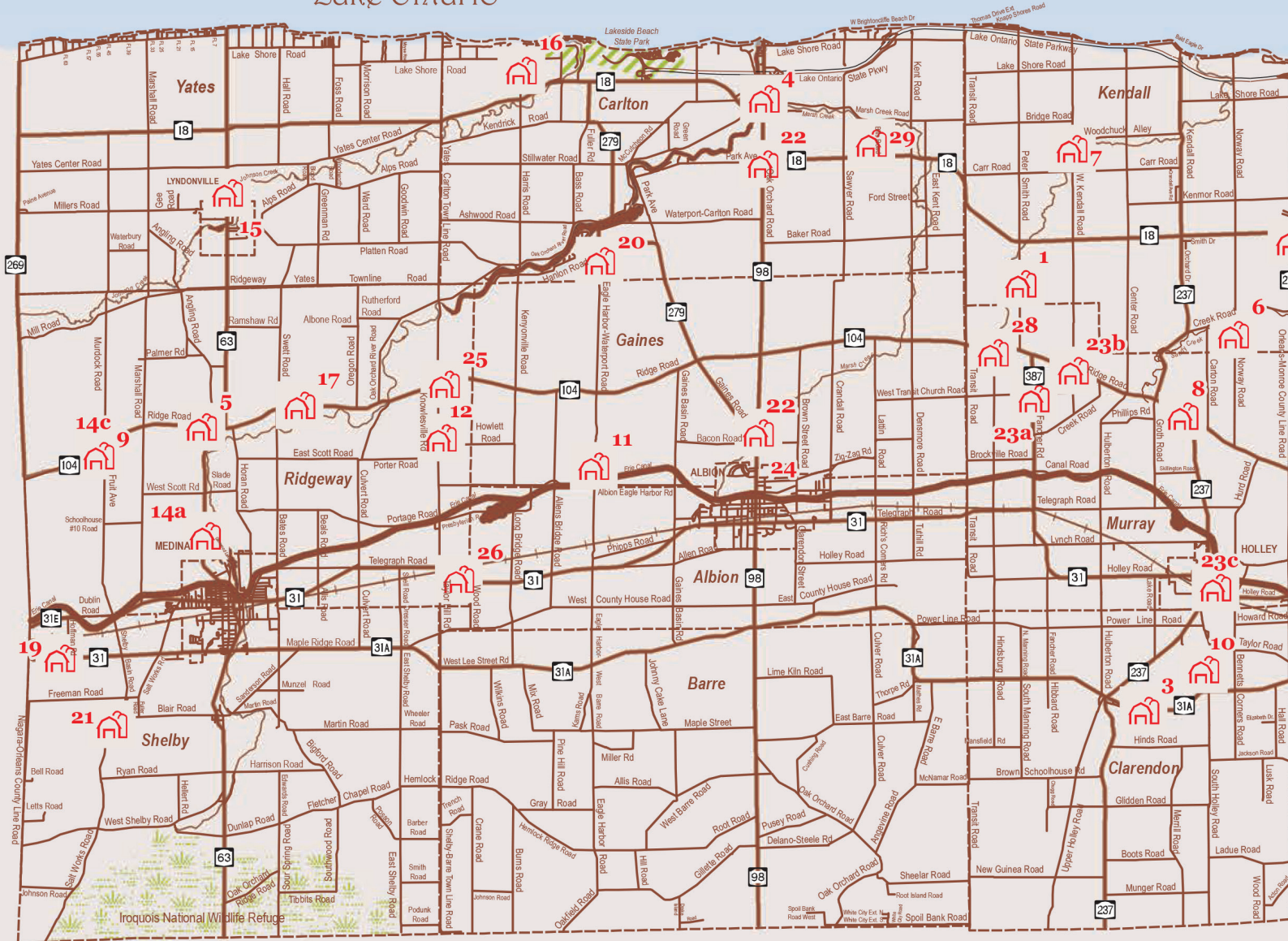

Orleans County Local Foods Map

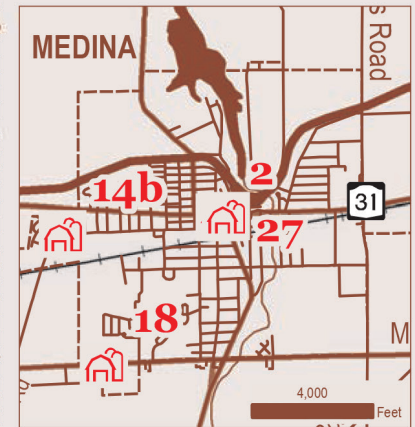


Lake Ontario
